Medical furniture, as a part of the Closed Loop Medication Management (CLMM) System

Over the course of the project, universal solutions will be developed so that furniture that is already available in hospitals can be integrated as part of a controlled medicine circulation. A comprehensive record of the hospital's medicines will be kept at the workstation (scanner, computer) that is integrated with the furniture.

The aim is to provide the healthcare sector with better-integrated solutions to reduce labour and warehousing costs related to the circulation of medicines., and to reduce potential treatment errors.

The project will achieve the following:

- Medicine cabinets with a controlled ventilation and cooling system.
- Pass-through cabinets with a fireproof and soundproof facade.
- The integration of medical furniture into hospitals' closed medicine circulation.
- Basic laboratory furniture products.
